Charitable Bequest (Will)

The most commonly used method of making charitable gifts, a bequest is private, inexpensive, changeable at any time, and does not deprive the donor of any asset or income they may need.

Charitable Gift Annuity

A CGA provides a donor an attractive income stream at a rate that is fixed for life. Diversify your income-producing assets and receive a current income tax deduction while bypassing capital gains.

Single Life* Charitable Gift Annuity Rates	
Age	Rate
65	5.3%
75	6.3
80	7.1
85	8.1
90+	9.5

*Two-life rates are lower.

Charitable Remainder Trust

A trust can provide income for you, your family, or both while allowing you to bypass capital gains and receive a current income tax deduction.

Usufruct/Life Estate Arrangement

Make a gift of your home, vacation home, or farm and continue to live there and/or collect rent during your lifetime and receive a current income tax reduction.

Beneficiary Clauses

Designate your church as the beneficiary of all or part of a retirement account or life insurance policy. An inexpensive method to help you set up a future gift without depriving you of any asset or income you may need during your life.
